### Flagstaff Accommodations

Flying M Air offers three options for accommodations in Flagstaff. Keep in mind that the two downtown hotels are renovated historic buildings and may be extremely noisy at night. Please select one:

- The Inn at 410** is a bed and breakfast about six blocks from downtown. It's a pleasant place, adjacent to the popular Brix restaurant.
- England House** is a bed and breakfast about six blocks from downtown. It's a small, pleasant place where the owner/managers make you feel at home.
- The Hotel Wetherford** is a small, historic hotel in downtown Flagstaff, close to shopping, dining, and nightlife.
- The Hotel Monte Vista** is a larger historic hotel in downtown Flagstaff, close to shopping, dining, and nightlife.

### Flagstaff Activities

Choose one of the following activities in the Flagstaff area:

- Hike at Walnut Canyon.** A rim hike shows distant views of ancient cliff dwellings; a hike down into the canyon brings you right up to these ruins.
- Visit Lowell Observatory.** A daytime visit includes a tour of this historic Mars Hill facility.
- Riorden Mansion.** Historic park visit includes hour-long guided tour of this unique two-family mansion.

### Doors-Off Aerial Photography

Flying M Air is pleased to offer doors-off aerial photography flights at most destinations. These flights give you an opportunity to explore the area around a destination as you choose. By taking one or more doors off the aircraft, you're ensured a glare-free photographic platform. **There's an additional charge of \$450/hour for these flights**, with a half-hour minimum per flight. If you think you may be interested, please check off the destinations you'd like to photograph so we can include the flight in your itinerary. No fee will be charged until the end of the excursion; you can change your mind about a flight with no penalty on the day of the flight if conditions are not what you expected.

- Sedona.** Area includes red rock cliffs and canyons, the Verde River, and the cliffside ghost town of Jerome, AZ. Best photographed early or late in the day.
- Lake Powell.** Seemingly endless collection of narrow, winding canyons with red rocks and blue sky. Good any time of day.
- Monument Valley area.** Flights over Monument Valley are limited, but the Goosenecks of the San Juan River are nearby and make excellent subject matter.
- Flagstaff area.** Multiple small volcano cinder cones north and east of the city. Meteor Crater is also a short flight from the Winslow refueling stop.
- Phoenix.** Do an aerial photo tour before or after your excursion. Great views of the city or the Salt River Canyon.
