Lake Powell Cruise

- Antelope Canyon Cruise.** Cruise scenic Antelope Canyon, with its dramatic steep, red sandstone walls. 1-1/2 hours.
- Half-day float trip.** Take a smooth-water ride down the Colorado, from Glen Canyon Dam to Lees ferry. 5 hours. Limited availability. (Note that due to the timing of this trip, it may not be possible to do both this trip and the Antelope Canyon land tour normally included with your excursion.)
- Canyon King Dinner Cruise.** Spectacular scenery, great food. Cruise Wahweap bay while you enjoy dinner. 2-1/2 hours. Limited availability.

Flagstaff Accommodations

Flagstaff Activities

- Hike at Walnut Canyon.** A rim hike shows distant views of ancient cliff dwellings; a hike down into the canyon brings you right up to these ruins.
- Visit Lowell Observatory.** A daytime visit includes a tour of this historic Mars Hill facility. The observatory is closed on Thursday nights for most of the year. If open at night during your trip, you can visit at night to look through the big telescopes (weather permitting).
- Visit the Museum of Northern Arizona.** Many exhibits covering the natural and cultural history of northern Arizona.
